

Healing - Hospital Handout

Isaiah 53:5 (King James Version) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace (shalom) was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

1 Peter 2:24b (King James Version) ...by whose stripes ye were healed.

Matthew 8:14-17 (King James Version) 14 And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. 15 And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them. 16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed **all** that were sick: 17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Jeremiah 17:14 (King James Version) Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.

Matthew 4:23-24 (King James Version) 23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing **all** manner of sickness and **all** manner of disease among the people. 24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

Acts 10:38 (King James Version) How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing **all** that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

John 17:18 (King James Version) As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

1 John 4:17 (King James Version) ...because as he is, so are we in this world.

John 14:12-14 (King James Version) 12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, **the works that I do shall he do also**; and **greater works** than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. 13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. 15 If ye love me, keep my commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

Mark 16:17a and 18b (King James Version) And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name ... they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Psalms 103:2-3 (King James Version) 2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: 3 Who forgiveth **all** thine iniquities; who healeth **all** thy diseases;

Psalms 107:20 (King James Version) He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Proverbs 4:20-24 (King James Version) 20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. 21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. 22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health (healing and medicine) to all their flesh.

23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life. 24 Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.

Romans 4:17b (King James Version) ,,even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.

Mark 11:23-24 (King James Version) 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

1 John 5:14-15 (King James Version) 14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: 15 And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

It is **always** God's will to heal - just like it is always God's will to save. So instead of saying "if it be thy will", let's rather pray "Lord, because **we know it is Your will to heal**, we ask you to effect a healing and a cure in Brother or Sister so & so.

In a hospital or some similar setting, in almost all cases, we read through some of these scriptures to build up their faith to receive healing, and so that they are not confused about what God's will is concerning healing. It's important for them to know that God did NOT cause the sickness any more than we would cause our own children to be sick...that Jesus bore all the sicknesses of the world when He bore all the sins of the world - at the same time - on the same cross. Notice Jeremiah 17.14 and 1 Peter 2.24 confirm this - Jeremiah 17.14 "Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved..." - notice healing **and** salvation - and 1 Peter 2.24 "Who his own self bare our **sins** in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to **sins**, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were **healed**." - notice all sins paid for and all sicknesses paid for at the same time.

It's important for them to know that our Heavenly Father wants them to be totally well even more than we want our own children well.

Healing is **always** God's will !!! We never see Jesus making anyone sick, nor do we ever see Him refusing to heal anyone. Our job as Christians, in ministering healing, is to, whenever possible, prepare the sick to receive their healing, through building faith from God's Word on healing, and then to pray for healing, scripturally (i.e. in line with God's Word). **NOW LET US PRAY !**
